



Figures 3 and 4 in Carney, Cuddy, and Yap (2010) compare the mean changes (± 1 SEM) in testosterone and cortisol levels between high- and low-power poses. The two figures above were similarly constructed for the current study. Contrary to Carney, Cuddy, and Yap (2010), these figures show no differences across poses for testosterone (left) and cortisol (right) and show that any changes within a condition are not different from zero.
